

Prof. Michael Glikson, MD, FESC, FACC - Abbreviated Curriculum Vitae 11/23

Director of the Jesselson Integrated Heart Center of Shaare Zedek Medical Center in Jerusalem and Professor of Cardiology at the Hebrew University of Jerusalem.

Trained in Electrophysiology (EP) and Pacing at the Mayo Clinic. Spent many years as the Head of EP and Pacing at the Sheba Medical Center, before becoming the Director of the Jesselson Heart Center.

My academic career is dedicated mainly to clinical research in EP and pacing, with main contributions in leading several multicenter device-related studies and registries. I have published more than 200 peer-reviewed original articles, nearly 50 other papers (chapters, reviews, case reports, etc.), and have presented hundreds of papers and invited talks at scientific meetings worldwide.

I am a past Chairman of the Israeli Working Group of Pacing and EP and past President of the Israel Heart Society. I am currently Chair of the National Council for Cardio-Vascular Disease in Israel.

I was an elected member of the European Society of Cardiology (ESC) Board (2018-2020), after having been a member of the ESC Scientific program committee. I Co-chaired the ESC 2021 Guidelines of Pacing and CRT. Chaired and co-chaired the European Heart Rhythm Association (EHRA) SPC 2013-2017. I am on the 2022-2024 ESC Board as a Chair of the Task Force on Big Data. Other tasks included membership in the ESC Membership Committee, EORP Committee, Euroheart Oversight Committee, EHRA Education and ACIQ, committees as well as the Nomination Committee.
